1. Quiet Hours: Students are often required to observe quiet hours during designated times to ensure a peaceful environment for study and rest.

3. Guest Policy: Hostels have restrictions on the entry of guests into the premises. Visiting hours are from 4 PM to 6 PM for parents' visits from Monday to Saturday.
4. Curfew: The hostel has a curfew time at 5:45 PM. This curfew is set for your security and safety reasons.
5. Alcohol and Substance Use: The use of alcohol and illegal substances is typically prohibited within the hostel premises. Violation of these rules can lead to disciplinary action.
6. Respect for Roommates: Nursing students are expected to respect the privacy and personal space of their roommates and neighbors. Disputes should be resolved amicably.
7. Respect for Hostel Staff: Politeness and respect toward hostel staff, including wardens, maintenance personnel, cooking staff, and security, is important.
8. Maintenance Requests: Students should promptly report any maintenance issues or problems with hostel facilities to the office at 0836-2354643.
9. Personal Hygiene: Maintaining personal hygiene and cleanliness is essential, both in the rooms and in common areas.
10. Study Hours: 8:30 PM to 11:30 PM specific study hours to ensure an environment conducive to academic pursuits.
11. Zero Tolerance for Harassment: Any form of harassment, bullying, or discrimination is usually not tolerated within the hostel environment.
12. Reporting Violations: If students witness violations of the rules or experience issues, they are encouraged to report them to hostel authorities.
13. Leave Permissions: Hostels require students to seek permission for overnight or extended leaves for safety and security reasons from the Principal.
14. Medical Assistance: Students who are suffering from any form of illness, whether mild or severe, should inform the Hostel Incharge or any seniors. They will be taken to KIMS Hospital, Hubli, for treatment, and further procedures will be communicated to parents. This facility is available 24 hours a day.
15. Absconding: Any student going out of the hostel without any permission or informing hostel authority will be considered as absconding, and disciplinary actions will be taken under the disciplinary committee headed by the Principal.
16. Hostel Management is not responsible for the loss of any valuable items, money, etc. We encourage students to use digital payments rather than using cash.
17. Any student who wishes to discontinue from the hostel has to Pay Full Hostel Fees of the Course.
